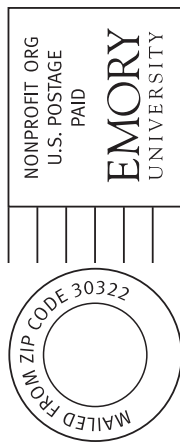

BENEFIT

Cardiovascular disease remains the number one killer of men and women in the United States, and is a major cause of disability. In order to improve patient outcomes and reduce cardiovascular risk, physicians and clinicians must gain the knowledge, skill, and resources to integrate the latest research and clinical guidelines in the context of their own practice.
